**Facts:** The Series received a report from Road America Security about a team member of TechSport Racing bringing a personal vehicle into the competitor's paddock, and disregarding the instructions of the Track Security staff who were managing paddock access.


**Supporting Documents:** Incident Report Doc # TC-9-A

**Decision:** After a hearing with Mr. Anderson, the Stewards admonished Mr. Anderson for his conduct with Track Security and reminded him of the implications of bringing personal vehicles into the competitor's paddock without prior arrangements with the Series. In particular, the Stewards called Mr. Anderson's attention to Sporting Regulations 15.4.2 – "Paddock Parking".

While the vehicle in question was a personal vehicle, it was being used as a source of parts to repair two team vehicles. That does not excuse the conduct of team members, nor does it relieve the team responsibility to request accommodations from the Series in the event of a need for an indulgence.

The Stewards assess TechSport Racing a \$100 fine, to be made to a charity to be identified by Road America management, and remind the team members of their obligations to adhere to the Sporting Regulations, and to observe regulations and instructions of the host facilities where we race.

The competitor is reminded of his right to appeal (Article 18) except where the penalties which are not susceptible to appeal.
